1) Trial Dates

Weekend 1 16th – 18st February 2024 (Templeogue) Weekend 2 8th – 10th March 2024 (Templeogue)

2) The format of the Trials will be a Teams event. Entries are invited from teams of four (4) or six (6) players. Each player in a team of six (6) must play at least 50% of the boards played by the team at each stage of the Trials in order to qualify for an invitation to represent Ireland in this event. no later than 15th January 2024 for teams with no player in the Open or Women's Trials. Teams with at least one (1) player playing in the Open or Women's Trials have until January 31st 2024 to enter.

The entry fee of €600 per team must be paid to Dermot O'Brien before 15th January 2024 for those teams with no player in the Open or Women's Trials or January 31st 2024 if they have a player from the Open or Women's Trials. (Please note the full entry fee for the team must be paid when the application is submitted ie it is not to be paid in pairs or individually) Entries without the entrance fee paid by the above dates will not be accepted.

3) Qualification

Each Player must have a minimum of 100 National Points or have won 50 in the past 3 years. (If all players on a team meet these requirements, then they are a qualifying team and do not need to seek derogation. The International Committee will consider written applications for derogation from players who do not meet these requirements. Such applications must set out in detail why entrants consider an application for derogation appropriate, and must be submitted to Dermot O'Brien, info@cbai.ie before 15th January 2024.

(Please note the International Committee discussed increasing the minimum number of National Points required but decided to leave it unchanged this year but it is expected to increase to at least 125 for the next IBU Trials)

- The exact format of the Trials will be announced after entries have been received. Please note all teams will not get to play for the second weekend. Please see Appendix 1 attached
- 5) Exemptions to Final Weekend **NONE**

- The winning team will be invited to represent Ireland. If a team of four qualifies then the third pair will be selected by the International Committee, after consultation with the winning team, from the entrants for the Trials. A reserve pair will also be nominated after consultation with the winning team. The NPC will be appointed by the International Committee after consultation with the players.
- 7) Grants. The IBU will pay an initial grant to each member of the team and the NPC.
- As most of you are aware, there are also Senior Trials this year (12th-14th March). Rather than forcing players playing in the Mixed Trials to enter for Seniors without knowing their own fate or the fate of some of their proposed teammates until after the Mixed Trials, the International Committee have agreed that any Senior who plays in the Mixed Trials in 2024 is automatically deemed to have expressed an interest in playing in the Senior Trials and any Senior team with at least one (1) player who plays in the Mixed Trials will be allowed to enter the Senior Trials up to midnight March 10th 2024.

(It would of course be very helpful if teams could enter for the Senior Trials long before the 10th March or at least contact one of the committee members and let them know of an intention to play – It might just help in arranging schedules etc)

(Please note if a player qualifies in the Open or Women's or Mixed Trials to represent Ireland then they cannot play in the Senior Trials)

The International Committee is empowered to alter any of the arrangements or conditions including time, dates and venue, and to decide on all matters affecting these Trials. Each player who enters is undertaking to represent Ireland if nominated and to abide fully with all the conditions of these Trials.

Appendix 1

1.1 Qualification:-

A team with a player or players without the required number of National Points (ie 100 national Points or 50 won in the past 3 years) can apply to the International Committee for a derogation as per the procedure outlined below.

- The application must be received no later than 15th January 2024.
- The entry fee of €600 must accompany the application.
- The application must detail why entrants consider their application appropriate and should detail recent results that they believe are of significance as well as any additional information they believe may be appropriate.

After receiving the application the International Committee will make a decision as to whether or not they will accept the team.

Please note those that teams that are not accepted will get a full refund of their entry fee.

1.2 Format:-

For the benefit of all those entering the Trials, once the qualifying number of teams has been obtained, it is envisaged that the format will be as follows:-

Mixed Trials

Please note that the proposed format for this event will be as follows:-

7 – 8	Round Robin	Semi Final / Final (Fri/Sat/Sun)
9 or more teams	Round Robin	Semi Final / Final (Fri/Sat/Sun)

The International Committee expects the times to be as follows-

Friday 18.30 hrs through to Sunday 18.00hrs, however depending on the number of teams entered, we may have to start as early as 11.00 am on the Friday or as late as 10.00 am on the Saturday of the first weekend to make sure of the smooth running of the event given the restriction on space and taking into account the possibility of large numbers.

For example twelve or more teams will definitely require an 11.00 am start on the first Friday.

We will confirm the exact format on 1st February 2024 after all entries are received. Bridge will definitely be finished by 18.00hrs Sunday of both weekends.

The Semi-Final / Final will be a 64 Board Semi-Final and an 80 board Final or in the case of only two teams entering it will be a Sat/Sun 112 board Final.

1.3 Systems

Please note that the Supplementary conditions of contest will also be issued on February 1st 2024 and please note Brown Sticker conventions & HUMS will be allowed but these conventions will need to be submitted along with proposed defences before 1st February 2024. All pairs system cards need to be submitted by 1st February 2024 also.

1.4 <u>Substitutes</u>

Subject to the approval of the International Committee (I.C.), a substitute may be allowed in emergency circumstances for a limited number of boards. A substitution, which in the opinion of the I.C. significantly affects the strength/weakness of a pair, is unlikely to be approved.

If a suitable substitute cannot be found for a match, the Tournament Director will award a score of 12 V.P. or such higher percentage achieved in the round robin, to the non-offending team for that match.

Requests for substitutes for what the I.C. considers to be convenience reasons will **not** be approved. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the T.D. is empowered to make emergency substitutions.
